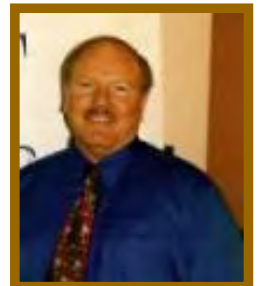

The tour destinations and commentary will be enlightening and for many who come - transformational. You and your family, church, organization, or home school group will take home from this exciting adventure a greater vision, cherished new friends, and a renewed hope for a new reformation.



## DAY 1- DEPART USA

## DAY 2- LONDON (B, D)

We suggest that all travelers arrive at the London Heathrow airport no later than 10:00am. Upon arrival in Heathrow proceed to the baggage claim area, after collecting your luggage and completing the customs process, you will be met by a professional tour guide outside of the customs area and escorted to a private motor coach for our transfer to central London. Before checking into our hotel we will enjoy a panoramic sightseeing tour of London, including Buckingham Palace, Big Ben, Tower Bridge, admission to The Tower of London and view the Crown Jewels, and where Henry VIII had his second wife, Anne Boleyn, beheaded as well as several other persons of royalty. Next it's a relaxing cruise down the River Thames from Tower Pier to Westminster with admission to Westminster Abbey- where all English Sovereigns have had coronations since that of William the Conqueror in 1066. We will note the empty part of the Coronation Seat, which once held the Stone of Destiny.. Afterwards, we'll board the coach for our transfer to the hotel, check-in and have time to relax before our group gathers this evening to enjoy a welcome to London dinner. **Overnight London**

## Day 3 – LONDON (B)

After a full English breakfast, we'll board our private motor coach for a transfer to Windsor Castle admission includes the State Apartments (if not in use). Afterwards, we'll return to our hotel. This afternoon is at your leisure to explore London on your own or you may wish to join Dr. Foster as he guides you through the London Museum. Tonight dinner will be on our own at one of London's restaurants. Perhaps you may want to include an optional performance at one of the famous West End Theatres! **Overnight London**

## DAY 4 – CAMBRIDGE/ SCROOBY (B, D)

After breakfast we continue our journey to the historic university town of Cambridge. Here we'll gather together for a devotional at the 500-year old King's College Chapel with its famous stained glass windows. We'll meet a local guide for a walking tour of the city and Cambridge University with its 31 colleges. We'll learn how Cambridge became the origin of Reformation in the 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> centuries. Then, we're off to York, but first a brief stop and photo opportunity in the quaint village of Scrooby. Here a group of religious dissenters, commonly referred to as the Pilgrims, left England seeking freedom of worship and years later founded the second permanent English settlement in North America, Plymouth Colony. Afterwards, we complete our day with dinner and overnight in the city of York. **Overnight York**

## DAY 5- YORK/ EDINBURGH (B)

After a full Scottish breakfast our group will join a local guide for a walking tour to explore the walled city of York, built between 1220 and 1470. For centuries York was one of England's grandest fortifications for the Romans, Vikings and Normans. We'll visit the Yorkshire Cathedral – the largest Gothic cathedral north of the Alps and a place of worship for over 1000 years. It is here where Constantine was made Roman Emperor and his statue outside the cathedral marks the spot. Next we drive to Edinburgh, including a brief stop to visit Lindisfarne Priory (tides permitting). This evening is free to dine on our own at a local restaurants. **Overnight Edinburgh**

## DAY 6- EDINBURGH (B, D)

After a full Scottish breakfast, our group will meet with a local tour guide for our private sightseeing tour of Edinburgh. The "Prince of Cities", we'll learn how the Reformation unfolds in the preaching of John Knox. Our host, Marshall Foster, will escort us as we see Knox's church where he preached from 1559 – 1572. He preached from this pulpit with such spirit-led passion that the Scottish people banished Mary, Queen of Scots and established principles of Christian self and civil liberty in the hearts of people. Here we will visit the Greyfriars Kirk and Churchyard and hear the story of the Scottish Covenanters, the Protestant martyrs who were imprisoned but stood for the truth of the gospel against the most powerful kings of Europe and bequeathed the legacy of Christian liberty to America. Our guide will take us to the historic sites of the Edinburgh Castle, the Queen's Holyrood Palace and the Royal Mile. We'll return to Edinburgh, for some free time to shop or

sightsee on our own before our group meets this evening for a traditional fun-filled Scottish banquet dinner and entertainment. **Overnight Edinburgh**

## DAY 7 – STIRLING/ST. ANDREWS (B)

Early morning departure today as we travel to city of Stirling and the William Wallace Monument. Here Wallace fought for the freedom of Scotland and where later the pastor and leader of the Covenanters, William Guthrie, was captured and taken out of the Church of the Holy Rude and martyred by the English King. Before returning to Edinburgh we'll make a stop in beautiful St. Andrews, the spiritual capitol of Scotland and the place where Scotland's Reformation began. During the time of the Reformation, St. Andrews University was third in significance, after Oxford and Cambridge. St. Andrews Castle, once the premier residence of bishops and archbishops is the site of battles and peace treaties. The reformer George Wishart was imprisoned here before being burned at the stake. We will note the marker identifying the place where he was martyred as well as the spot of Patrick Hamilton's martyrdom. We'll view St. Andrews Cathedral which dates back to 1160 and now comprises the ruins of Scotland's largest cathedrals and the monument to Robert the Bruce, the first king to unite the Scottish people is also here in this city. This evening dinner will be on our own to enjoy a local restaurant or pub. **Overnight Edinburgh**

## DAY 8 – STEAM TRAIN EXCURSION (B, D)

A drive to the train station to board Central Scotland's Steam Railway for a ride to Fireclay Mine and a visit to the Scottish Railway Exhibition. Afterwards, we'll return to Edinburgh late afternoon with time to relax before our group meets this evening for our farewell dinner. **Overnight Edinburgh**

## DAY 9 – EDINBURGH / USA (B)

This morning we begin our trip home with new inspiration from our Reformation Journey, more ready to meet the challenge of inspiring others with God's providential story.
